

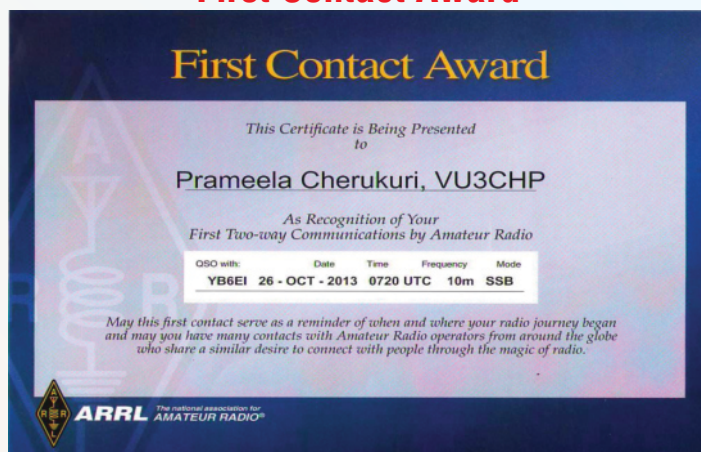
Inauguration of Amateur Radio Club Station VU2SQL at S.N.Trust Higher Secondary School, Chertala

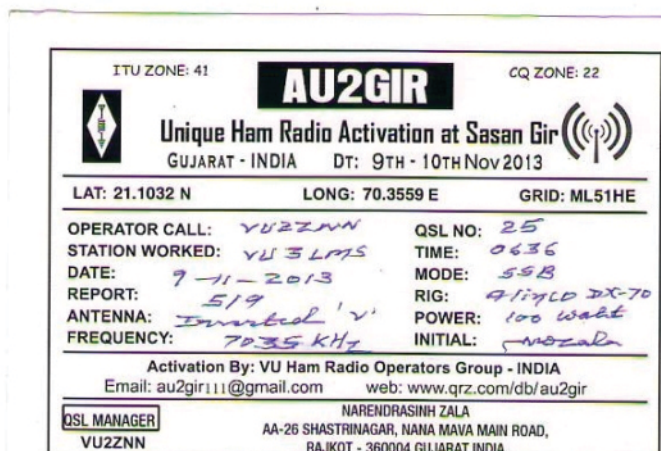
Inauguration of Lamakaan Repeater
